



**Policy:** Release and reassignment of inactive POC Competition Car Numbers

**Date:** May 2005, revised from March 2000

**Purpose:** To define the policy and procedure for the release and reassignment of inactive **one** and two digit car numbers

**Definitions:**

**Competition Car Numbers** will be assigned by the Competition Director or designee. (see 20.1 of the GCR's)

**Inactive car number-** if a member does not **compete in at least one event during the calendar year (using his car number)** the car number is deemed to be inactive. (see 20.2 of the GCR's)

**Active member** - An active member is defined as one who is paid in full for all required licenses and membership dues.

**Rules for release and reassignment of inactive Competition Car Numbers:**

1. An inactive car number will be eligible for release and reassignment after the last event of the calendar year unless the member qualifies for an exemption.
2. A one-year exemption may be given by a majority vote of the Board of Directors. A letter to a Board Member must be received before the last event of the year stating the extenuating circumstances to be considered. (20.2 of the GCR's)
3. Exemptions cannot be granted in concurrent years.
4. A list will be conducted to release the available **one and/or** two digit numbers.

5. All active members that meet a “minimum criterion” will be eligible to obtain a one or two digit Car Number if they are not on a 13/13 suspension. The criterion will be based on Membership, Participation, Award Recognition, Service and Volunteerism. Points are accumulated as described below:
  - 1 point for every year of “active” membership
  - 2 points for each major Service year end award (Service points Champion, Member of the Year)
  - 1 point for each major Performance year end award (Driver of the year, Competition points Champion)
  - 2 points for every year with 1,000 service points or more
  - 2 points for each year of service as a Board Member or Comp Director
  - 1 point for each year as a Committee Chairperson
6. To be eligible for a two digit number a member must accumulate at least 10 points. For a one digit number a member must accumulate at least 25 points. Those members with the most points get first pick of the available numbers.
7. All members wishing to participate in the one and/or two digit number release program will notify the Competition Director or designee in writing. No verbal requests will be accepted.
8. Members may request a specific number or request to be assigned any 1 or 2 digit number that is available. All members requesting a one or two digit number will be listed on a master list with their accumulated criterion points.
9. A release of one and two digit numbers will be conducted by the Competition Director after the last event of the year and thereafter as deemed necessary.
10. Members will be notified after selection is made. Notification will be in writing by e-mail, fax or letter.
11. Members have the right to exchange their Competition number with one another. The exchange is the sole responsibility of the members, but must be reported to the Competition Director or designee in writing, dated and signed by both members.
